Notes:

1. In most cases students are required to take English 110 before beginning the major, but with permission students may co-enroll in English 110 and the required introduction to the major, English 200.
2. Students are advised to complete the 200 level surveys in English and American literatures (220,221,224,225) as preparation for upper division courses (300 level), and they are required to take the Senior Seminar (English 400) in the second semester of the senior year. Totals for the major: 11 courses, 33 semester hours.
3. English 361 and 362 (Shakespeare) are offered only in the Spring Semester of each year.
4. Although it is possible to take a remaining major elective course during the Senior Seminar semester, the Department does not recommend it.
