

Political Science

Be aware that the Political Science department is in the process of making some changes in our curriculum.

The most significant change is that the department requires 34 rather than 30 credits in Political Science for our majors.

Students must take one course from all four areas of Political Science:

- American Politics (POLS 103)
- Comparative Politics (POLS 200)
- Introduction to International Relations (POLS 270)
- Political Theory, (POLS 411)

Students must also take one course out of the following: American Foreign Policy, State and Markets, Environmental Politics and Politics of Criminal Justice.

Seniors must complete a two semester sequence (4 credit hours, 1 credit in Fall and three in Spring) of senior seminar. (POLS 415)
